

KENTUCKY REGISTRY OF ELECTION FINANCE CASE NO. 2016-39

In re: Matt Teaford, Candidate for Kentucky House of Representatives, District 67, and Treasurer of the Campaign Fund of Matt Teaford for State Representative, District 67

The above-styled case will be heard by the Kentucky Registry of Election Finance (Registry) at its next regular meeting to be held on Thursday, September 29, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. EDT in the Registry's office at 140 Walnut Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601. Appearance by Respondent(s) at the Registry's meeting is permitted, but not required. Please contact the Registry's General Counsel if you wish to appear before the Registry at its meeting.

SUPPLEMENTAL STAFF REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

On June 1, 2016, Respondent Matt Teaford (Teaford), Candidate for the Kentucky House of Representatives, District 67, and Treasurer of the Campaign Fund of Matt Teaford for State Representative, District 67 (Teaford Campaign Fund), was sent notice of a Complaint filed by Paul L. Whalen (Whalen), alleging violations of KRS 121.180 and 32 KAR 1:020 based on Teaford's failure to file the 32 Day Pre Election Finance Statement, due to be filed with the Registry by no later than April 20, 2016, via certified mail, return receipt requested. The allegations in Whalen's complaint and Teaford's additional failure to file the 15 Day Pre Election Finance Statement, due to be filed by no later than May 9, 2016, formed the basis of the General Counsel's reason to believe finding that Teaford had violated provisions of the campaign finance law (KRS Chapter 121).¹

As of July 15, 2016, the Notice and Staff Report was returned to the Registry as "Unclaimed." On September 6, 2016, the Registry re-mailed the Notice and Staff Report via U.S. Mail, First Class postage pre-paid. This Notice and Supplemental Staff Report is sent to provide Teaford notice of the date and time of the upcoming Registry meeting and to recommend Registry action based on the following facts as reflected in Registry records:

- Teaford's Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Optional Request for Reporting Exemption, received and filed in the Kentucky Secretary of State's Office on January 19, 2016, indicated Teaford's intent to raise and spend more than \$3,000 in the 2016 primary and general elections.³
- 2. To date, the Registry has received no reports for and on behalf of the Teaford Campaign Fund for the 2016 primary election cycle. The reports that are overdue and the corresponding delinquency case references are as follows: the 32 Day Pre Election Finance Statement, due no later than April 20, 2016 (Case No. 2016-32), the 15 Day Pre Election Finance Statement, due no later than May 9, 2016 (Case No. 2016-48), and the 30 Day Post Election Finance Statement, due no later than June 21, 2016 (Case No. 2016-81).
- 3. Registry records reflect that Teaford was notified of failure to file the 32 Day Pre Election Finance Statement, Case No. 2016-32, by telephone call on April 27, 2016, to which Teaford verbally advised Registry staff he would file delinquent report same day; however, he did not.

- 4. Registry records reflect that Teaford was sent written notice of his failure to file the 32 Day Pre Election Finance Statement (Case No. 2016-32) and 15 Day Pre Election Statement by letter dated May 20, 2016.⁴
- 5. Teaford was again notified of the delinquent Pre Election Finance Statements (32 Day Pre and 15 Day Pre), in addition to the delinquent 30 Day Post Election Finance Statement, due to be filed by no later than June 21, 2016 (Case No. 2016-81), by letter dated July 13, 2016.⁵
- 6. The Registry is unable to reach Teaford via telephone as the phone numbers reported on his KREF-001 Form (859-446-1068 and 859-496-7699) are "not accepting calls."
- 7. Teaford is designated as a current candidate for the 2016 General Election with a spending intent of more than \$3,000, which requires full pre and post election reporting of campaign finances by the Teaford Campaign Fund.
- 8. This case incorporates by reference and supercedes the following delinquency case matters: Case No. 2016-32 (32 Day Pre Election Finance Statement), Case No. 2016-48 (15 Day Pre Election Finance Statement), and Case No. 2016-81 (30 Day Post Election Finance Statement).

ISSUE

The sole issue before the Registry is whether Respondent, Matt Teaford, has knowingly failed to file required Election Finance Statements fully disclosing the finances of the Teaford Campaign Fund for the 2016 primary election.

ANALYSIS

The core purpose of Kentucky's campaign finance law is to assure the integrity of the Commonwealth's electoral process by providing the public full access to a candidate's campaign financial data. To that end, KRS 121.180(3) requires a candidate's designated campaign Treasurer to fully report to the Registry "all money, loans, or other things of value, received from any source, and expenditures authorized, incurred and made" on behalf of a candidate's campaign. All candidate campaigns - with the limited exception of those who elect to raise or spend \$3,000.00 or less in an election - are required to file a Pre Election Finance Statement thirty-two (32) days before an election. See KRS 121.180(3)(b)2. In addition, all candidate campaigns - with the limited exception of those who elect to raise or spend \$1,000.00 or less in an election - are required to file Pre Election Finance Statement fifteen (15) days before an election. See KRS 121.180(3)(b)3. Finally, all candidate campaigns - with the limited exception of those who elect to raise or spend \$1,000.00 or less in an election - are required to file a Post Election Finance Statement thirty (30) days after an election. See KRS 121.180(4).

Despite numerous notices of pre and post election reporting requirements sent to Teaford, no reports or responses have been received to date. Teaford has failed to keep the Registry apprised of current contact information and appears to be evading the Registry's attempts to serve notice of this case. He will appear as a candidate on the 2016 general election ballot having filed no election finance statements or having otherwise provided the Registry with notice of where he is located or any explanation whatsoever for his failure to file the required reports.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on the record of this case, in the absence of any filing or contact whatsoever with the Registry regarding the delinquent filings, the General Counsel recommends that the Registry find probable cause to believe that Teaford has knowingly failed to file required Election Finance Statements fully disclosing the finances of the Teaford Campaign Fund, in violation of KRS 121.180 and 32 KAR 1:020.

Pursuant to KRS 121.140(5), if the Registry concludes that there is probable cause to believe that the campaign finance law has been violated knowingly, it shall refer the violation to the Attorney General for further investigation and potential prosecution. KRS 121.990(3) provides that any person who knowingly fails to file required reports or to file reports at times specified shall be guilty of a Class D felony. Therefore, the General Counsel further recommends that the Registry refer this case to the Office of the Attorney General for further investigation and potential prosecution.

Section 10 of 32 KAR 2:040 provides that failure to comply with the reporting requirements of KRS 121.180 constitutes prima facie evidence that probable cause exists to believe a violation may have occurred. An administrative penalty accrues for each day that an election finance statement is late.

In addition, the Registry has no record of having received your 15 Day Pre Election Finance Statement, which was due to be filed on Monday, May 9, 2016.

Registry records indicate that the 30 Day Post Election Finance Statement, due no later than June 21, 2016, for Candidate Matt Teaford, has not been filed. Furthermore, Registry records indicate that the 32 Day and 15 Day Pre Election Finance Statements due no later than April 20, 2016 and May 09, 2016, respectively, have yet to be received. In a letter dated, May 20, 2016, the Registry attempted to alert you to these delinquencies; however, no response has been received.
